The Manner of Execution of Subsidy Programmes

- Name of the Programme/Scheme : Capital Investment Subsidy Scheme for Construction/Renovation/Expansion of Rural Godowns
- Duration of the programme/scheme : 12.04.2002 to 31.03.2012. Now the scheme has been implemented for the Financial Year 2009-10 also.
- Objective of the programme: To provide the farming Community with facilities for Scientific storage of Agricultural Produce so that wastage & deterioration of produce are avoided. The farmers may sell their produce at a time when the prices are high
- Physical and Financial targets of the programme (for the 2009-10): 890 lakhs
- Eligibility of Beneficiary: Any beneficiary having land required as per the Rural godown to be constructed at a place other than the Municipal Corporation Limits.
- Pre-requisites for the benefit: The beneficiary should avail loan from Bank and should construct the Rural Godown accordance with the specifications laid down by GoI under the scheme
- Procedure to avail the benefits of the programme: The claims of Advance Subsidy under the scheme shall be submitted to NABARD/DMI after the sanction of loan. Joint Inspection Committee consisting of officers from NABARD/DMI /Bank shall inspect the Rural Godown and on their recommendations the Bank will send final subsidy claims alongwith the required documents to NABARD for its release.
- Criteria for deciding eligibility: The Beneficiary should own required land as per capacity of the Godown and should arrange 25% Margin Money for availing loan from the Bank.
- Detail of the benefits given in the programme. (Also mention the amount of subsidy or other help given): Subsidy @ 25% of the total project outlay is provided and 50% of the advance subsidy is released by NABARD on the issue of Loan Sanction Order by the Primary Bank and the remaining 50% final subsidy shall be released by NABARD on recommendations of the Joint Inspection Committee.
